

1. **Entry forms must be returned no later than 8<sup>th</sup> June 2012.** LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
2. An entry fee of **\$20.00** (non-refundable) is payable with the attached Entry Form. Cheques should be made payable to **Derinya Primary School**.
3. Jewellery Exhibitors may enter **up to 50 pieces** of their original work into the Exhibition. The number of pieces on display by each Jewellery Exhibitor will correlate with the available space and will be displayed at the discretion of the Jewellery Boutique Coordinators.
4. Acceptance of entries and display of exhibits shall be at the sole discretion of DACE's Jewellery Boutique Coordinators, who reserve the right to refuse any entry or to display an exhibit.
5. Delivery is on **Tuesday, 17<sup>th</sup> July**, between the hours of **9.30am–2.30pm** and **7.30pm–8.30pm**. Please deliver entries to the **DACE Jewellery Boutique, Derinya Primary School, cnr Overport Road & Derinya Drive, Frankston South**. LATE DELIVERIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
6. All exhibits must be individually labelled (with price and code) and a Jewellery Boutique Inventory Form must be completed and delivered with all entries. **UNLABELLED WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
7. The Jewellery Exhibitor shall permit multi-media advertising relating to their entries (refer to Permission Clause included with mailed entry forms).
8. The DACE Committee shall retain 25% of the selling value of any exhibit sold, including any orders placed during or as a result of the Exhibition. All proceeds from sales go to the Derinya Primary School Council. Jewellery Exhibitors should allow at least 30 days following the Exhibition for cheques to arrive by mail.
9. Delivery and pick-up (including mailing) of all Jewellery Boutique exhibits (including display cases, etc) is at no cost to DACE or Derinya Primary School.
10. The Jewellery Exhibitor or his/her authorised agent, must collect any unsold works on **Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2012** between **6.00pm–8.00pm**. Pick-ups before 6.00 pm are not permitted as displays are not dismantled before this time. No responsibility will be taken by DACE or the school for items not collected by the stated pick-up time.
11. The DACE Committee will exercise all possible care in handling the works submitted. Derinya Primary School has supplementary insurance to cover the exhibits whilst in the possession of the DACE Committee; from delivery (17/7/12) until pick-up (22/7/12).
12. Jewellery Exhibitors can be assured that our talented DACE Committee shall display their works to their full advantage.
13. The Judges' decisions will be final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into.
